What this form is used for

This form is a Codicil Form and allows you to add a gift to an existing will. The gift can either be cash or a specific gift.

Please note when filling in this form

There are several points you should take into account:

- If possible, seek professional advice from your solicitor. This can include if you have any questions or concerns and ensure it ties in properly with the rest of your will.
- If you would like to leave part or all of your residuary estate (i.e. a share or whole), we advise that you replace an existing will and consult a solicitor or legal professional.

Witnesses

- This form needs to be signed in the presence of two witnesses, and they both need to sign the form when you do. Note that in Scotland only one witness is required, whilst two are required in England, Wales, and Northern Ireland.

They cannot be

- Individuals who stand to benefit from your will or this codicil.
- Direct family members (including your spouse/civil partner).
- The executor, trustee, or beneficiary of your will or any codicil.
- An executor's or trustee's spouse or civil partner.

Once the form is completed

- Once completed, this codicil should be kept with your will. However, it should not be stapled or attached in any way.
- Take a photocopy of your codicil and send the original to your solicitor, or whoever is safeguarding your will.
